

PROMISE CAMP 2018 – PACKING LIST

Please make sure that all belongings are properly marked with your child's full name. Bags and luggage must be clearly marked with child's name. Send enough clothing for the week as the camp does not have laundry facilities for campers. Please remember we are not responsible for anything that a child brings to camp. We will make every effort to see that your child returns with all of his/her clothes; however, we cannot be responsible for unmarked clothing left behind. - **Medications (in original bottles with intact labels)**

DO NOT BRING any of the following: Phones, electronics, expensive cameras, jewelry, video games, portable music players, money, knives, drugs, alcohol, personal sports equipment or anything expensive. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items, and these items will be confiscated if they are found.

MEDICAL ISSUES: We must have a completed medical form completed by the parent/guardian or physician no later than the Thursday before your camper's session or your child will not be able to attend. **Please send all medications in their original containers; they will not be given otherwise.** No medication will be given to the child if beyond the expiration date or if labels are not intact. All medicine will be locked in the nurse's office and given only by the nurse or her designate. Note: Inhalers & EpiPen's must be accompanied by their original box with the prescription label and will only be given by the nurse or her designate. Make sure there are complete instructions for all medications. Please do not send over-the-counter medications unless they have been prescribed by a doctor. The Nurse will be at the bus stop to receive all medications and to verify their use (please have medications ready).

PLEASE NOTE: Please do not stop by to visit your child. It can be disruptive and can hinder the child's adjustment at camp. It is also unfair for other children who do not have visitors. If you have a concern, please contact one of the staff

MAIL: Please write to your child at PROMISE CAMP, 227 LANCE ROAD, CLINTON, PA 15026. It takes 2-3 days for your mail to arrive at camp so write your letters early.

PHONE CALLS: The camp phones are for emergencies only. Please do not call to talk with your child. We will call you if your child needs significant medical attention, has significant behavior or adjustment problems while at camp, or if there is a change in the bus schedule. If you have questions about bus times/locations or camp activities, you can call the Camp Registrar at 412-916-9634.

Please check-in with the Camp Registrar at your bus stop promptly at the above times. She will sign you in and give your camper permission to board the bus. The Camp Nurse will collect all medications and discuss any last-minute health concerns. Camper safety is paramount to us and our staff are trained in transportation safety. Several of those summer camp staff will be at the bus stops to help load and unload and they'll ride the bus and van as chaperones to and from camp.

For parents NOT needing bus transportation, please bring your child to camp on Sunday at 4:45pm and return for them at camp on Friday at 4:00p. Go to 227 Lance Road, Clinton, PA 15026.

Going To Camp: We will be at the bus stops 30 minutes prior to departure on Sunday. However, if there are delays with traffic or boarding at previous stops, we may be late to your stop. Once you check in your child with us and providing all medications in their original bottles with intact labels, we will allow your child to board the bus. Once we give your child permission to board, please leave the area in order to avoid crowding and confusion. Your child will be well supervised, and once we are 15 minutes past the departure time, they will proceed to camp. Please remind your child that while on the bus they must follow all bus rules (remain in their seats, no food, "quiet voices" and absolutely no fights). Your cooperation is essential to our success and your child's safety. Please also make sure all luggage and bags are clearly marked with your child's name.

Coming Home: When your child arrives at the bus stop, you (the parent or guardian who signed the registration form) will be asked sign out to retrieve your child. If you wish another adult (even the other parent) to pick up your child, then you must have stated this on your registration or medical form under emergency contacts. We retain the right to not release your child to anyone should these criteria not be met.

Children will return to the same locations above on the camp bus. Please be on time to meet the buses. It is extremely frightening for a child not to be met on time. We will try to contact you if you are not there on time, but, if you are more than 1/2 hour late, we will be forced to call the police and leave the child in their custody.
